What will the church service be like?

The service generally looks like this:

Welcome and a prayer from Pastor Bill

Sing some songs along with our Praise Band

Pastor Bill will share an encouraging and relevant message

Another song will be sung along with an invitation to respond to any decision God may leading someone to make.

The offering will be taken. Do not feel obligated to give, feel free to let the offering plate pass you by and let us minister to you as our guest.

We will be using some visual means to share words to the songs, announcements, and any other information needed. It is our desire that this means of communication will enhance your worship time with us and keep us all informed of the work of God in our church.

What is the music like?

Music has the power to speak to the heart! At North Cross, you will experience music led by our praise team. The music is at times upbeat and celebrative and at other times reflective and worshipful. We sing a variety of music that is easy to learn and remember.

What are the messages like?

At North Cross you will hear messages focused on real life issues.
